## ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

On December 9, 1999, pursuant to G.L.c. 166A, § 14, AT\&T Corp. ("AT\&T") and M ediaOne of Massachusetts, Inc. and M ediaOne Group, Inc. ("M ediaOne") filed an appeal from the City of Newton's vote to deny the license transfer from M ediaOne to AT\&T. The matter was docketed as CTV 99-6. The City filed its A nswer on December 24, 1999. On A pril 27, 2000, all parties filed a stipulation to dismiss this appeal with prejudice.

Pursuant to G.L. c. 30A, § 10, the Cable Division may dispose of a matter by stipulation or agreed consent. As all parties agree to the dismissal of this matter, we accept the parties' request.

Accordingly, it is hereby
ORDERED: That the appeal of M ediaOne of M assachusetts, Inc., et all. is dismissed with prejudice.
