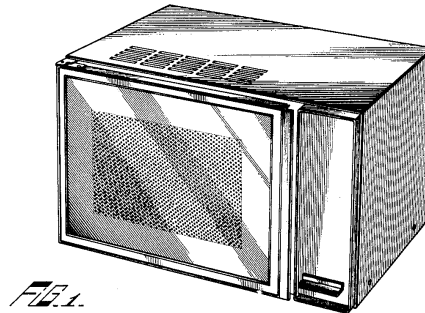

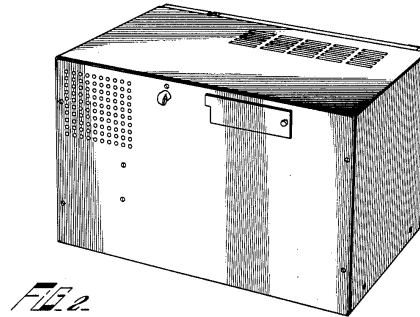

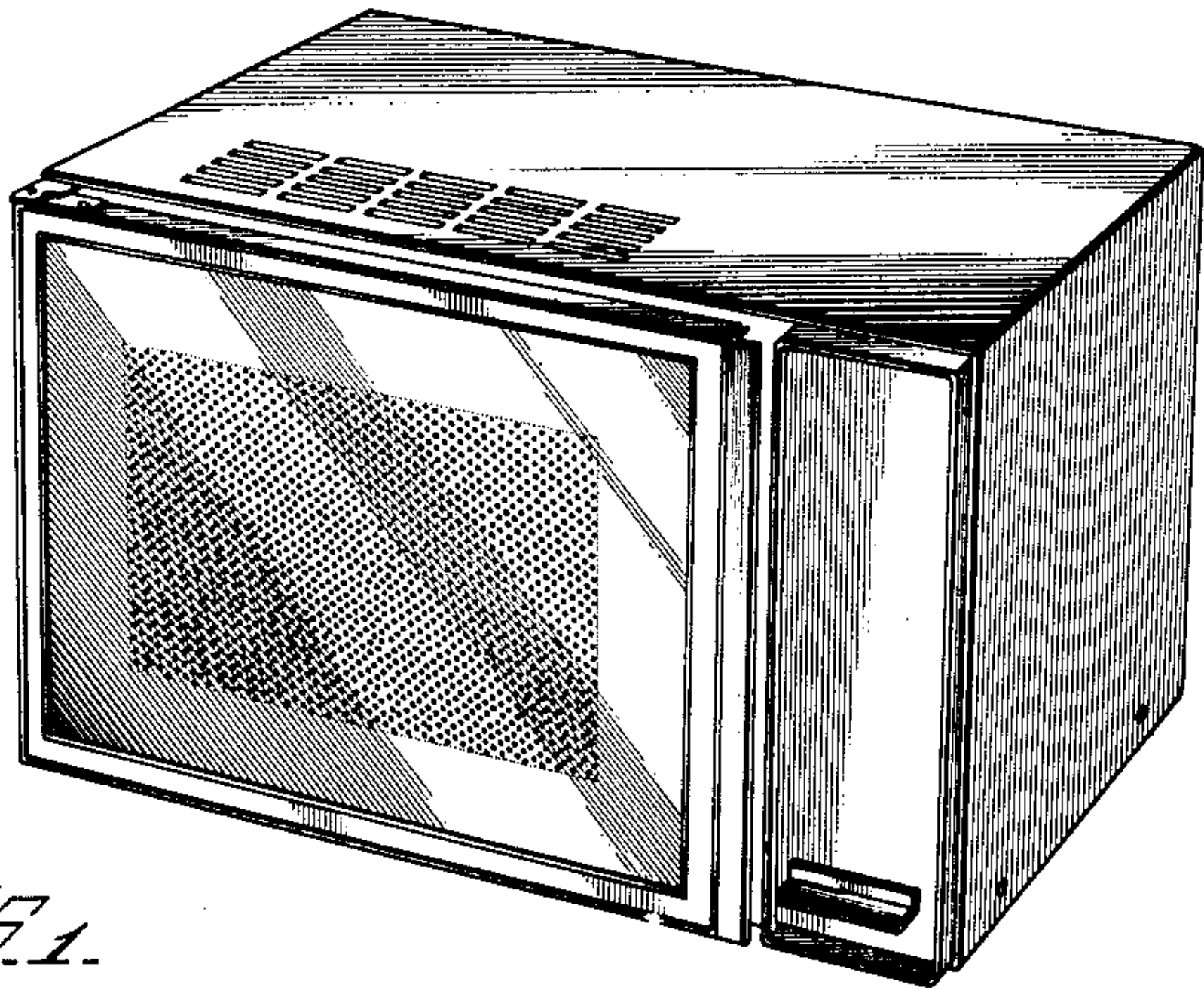

Litton Model 419



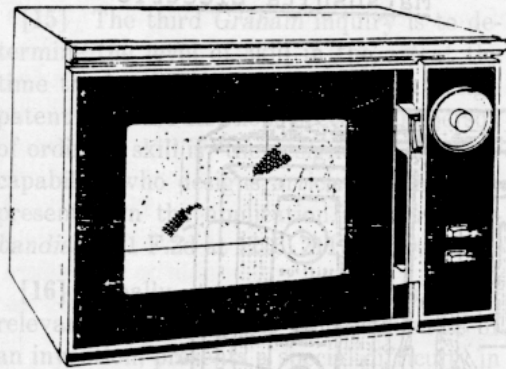

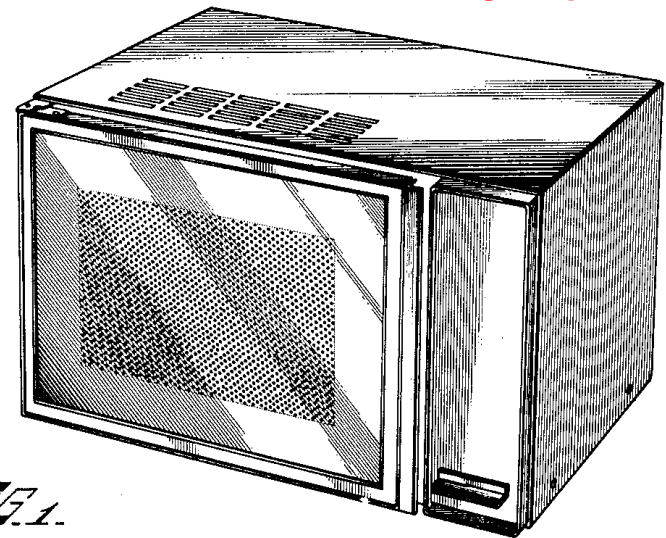
